

## INTAKE PROTOCOL FOR NEWBORN ORPHANS

- 1) Dawn flea bath before crating so no fleas transfer to bedding
- 2) Start colostrum, per package instructions
- 3) Check all body areas for any unusual signs of illness or distress
- 4) Stimulate bathroom duties before feeding
- 5) Feed room temp KMR every 2-3 hours and keep records!!
- 6) If diarrhea is present, add pumpkin puree to formula. Pumpkin can also be used for constipation, so you have to watch closely to know when to start/stop the pumpkin.
- 7) Stimulate bathroom duties again
- 8) Make sure kennel is lined with soft blankets, heating pad, preferably for pets so it is pressure sensitive, and line with pee pads.
- 9) Must place a stuffed animal in the kennel so they have something to snuggle with.
- 10) Keep the kennel covered with a blanket so as to keep light to a minimum and keep the warmth in.
- 11) Check for fleas every feeding or at least once a day and give Dawn bath if you see ANY!! Fleas can kill a kitten in a matter of hours if not treated. Lather up with Dawn and let the Dawn stay on them for at least 4-5 minutes in order to suffocate/kill them. Will not kill eggs so will have to repeat in a few days.

Colostrum-LD powder \*  
Light Karo syrup  
3-5 mil syringes w/needles for subq fluids  
Pet wipes  
Pee pads 22x22 size  
Round cotton pads  
Eye medication/ointment

NutraMax Immuquin Immune Support powder \*
